## **School Uniform**

### **Boys:**

School navy sweatshirt (crew or v-neck)\*

White shirt: Long sleeved cotton shirt for winter  
Short sleeved polo shirt for summer. (Polo shirts are preferable all year round for Reception children)

Grey trousers or shorts

Grey socks

Dark coloured shoes not trainers

### **Girls:**

School navy sweatshirt (crew or v-neck) or navy cardigan\*

White shirt: Long sleeved cotton shirt for winter  
Short sleeved polo shirt for summer

Grey skirt or tunic

White socks / navy or grey tights

Navy check or striped dress for summer

Grey or navy tailored trousers or shorts

Dark coloured shoes not trainers (low heels with covered toes)

### **Sports clothes:**

Navy cotton shorts or plain navy or black lycra shorts

Coloured T-shirt in house colour\*

Plimsolls or Trainers for outside sport for the summer term

Optional navy tracksuit bottoms for outside on cold days

### **Notes**

Football team will be expected to wear football boots, shin pads and kit (shirts, shorts and socks are provided for fixtures)

The school will supply ties for the children to wear on special occasions.

Shoulder length or longer hair should be fastened back. No Hair Gel

For safety's sake, jewellery is not allowed to be worn and we actively discourage earrings. If ears are pierced then only plain studs may be worn and the child must be able to remove them for PE themselves.

It is important that all clothing is marked with a clear name label.

Please provide sports clothes in a simple draw-string bag.
