## BOYS

- School navy sweatshirt (crew or v-neck)
- White shirt / Polo shirt. *NB Polo shirts are preferable all year round for Reception children as these are easier when changing.*
- Grey trousers or shorts
- Grey socks
- Black shoes, no trainers.

## GIRLS

- School navy sweatshirt (crew or v-neck) or navy cardigan
- White shirt / Polo shirt. *NB Polo shirts are preferable all year round for Reception children as these are easier when changing.*
- Grey skirt or tunic, no shorter than 2" above the knee
- White socks / navy tights
- Grey tailored trousers
- Navy check or striped dress for summer
- Black shoes with low heels, no trainers.

### SPORTS CLOTHES

Please provide sports clothes in a suitable small bag as there is limited space in the cloakrooms.

- Navy shorts (lycra or cotton)
- Coloured t-shirt in house colours, you will be advised of your child's house colour.
- Trainers for outside sport
- Optional navy tracksuit bottoms for outside in winter/cold days
  - **a.** The football team need football boots, shin pads and kit (the school provides shirts for matches)

# SECOND HAND UNIFORM

The School does have a stock of second hand uniform and hold sales periodically throughout the school year.

## HAIR STYLES

Shoulder length or longer hair should be fastened back. No decorative hair clips No hair gel

#### JEWELLERY

No jewellery is permitted, including friendship bracelets No earrings except for studs for pierced ears. These must be removed for PE. Should your child be unable to do this themselves, they should be taken out at home.

#### **BOOK BAGS**

All children should have a book bag to bring their work and other items to and from school. These are available priced £2.50 in red, blue, green or yellow from the office; alternatively TEC offer a navy bag with the school logo priced £6.50 and available to order using their ordering process.

### LOST PROPERTY

We hope that by naming all items of clothing and property this can be avoided. However if your child loses clothing or another item, please ask the class teacher or teaching assistant in the first instance. Fiona Waters, our caretaker, often finds such items, alternatively enquire at the office as sometimes valuables are left there. Named items are usually reunited with their owner very quickly. We would ask that the children do not bring valuable toys and other possessions into school as we cannot be responsible for these. Reception children may bring in a small pocket sized toy daily to aid their settling into school.
