### Local COVID restrictions

Across West Sussex our local COVID alert level is medium.

### This means:

- you must not socialise in groups larger than six, indoors or outdoors (other than where a legal exemption applies)
- businesses and venues can continue to operate, in a COVID-secure manner, other than those that remain closed in law
- certain businesses are required to ensure customers only consume food and drink while seated, and must close between 10pm and 5am
- businesses and venues selling food for consumption off the premises can continue to do so after 10pm as long as this is through delivery service, click-and-collect or drive-through
- Schools, universities, nurseries and childcare remain open
- places of worship remain open, subject to the <u>rule of six</u>
- weddings and funerals can go ahead with restrictions on numbers of attendees
- exercise classes and organised sport can continue to take place outdoors, or indoors
  if the <u>rule of six</u> is followed

### You must:

• wear a face covering in those areas where this is mandated

### You should continue to:

- follow social distancing rules
- work from home where you can effectively do so

Aim:


- to fill your class jar with the most pennies. The class with the most pennies WINS!
