Look, cover, write, check

I have prepared six of these, one for each of the next six weeks. The idea is that the words on the left hand side are looked at, one at a time, then covered one at a time, then written one at a time. This activity is aimed at supporting spellings. These words could also be cut up into cards and played as a bingo or snap game. All of the words contain the year 2 spelling patterns.

Another activity could be to write silly sentences using as many or as few of these words as possible. In class we sometimes tried using as many of these words as we could in a short paragraph. We often ended up in fits of laughter! Please remind the children to use capital letters, full stops, question marks and or exclamation marks. When the word is used it could be crossed off, highlighted or written in a different colour.
