Spotlight on safeguarding – getting to know what your child is doing online



The key to helping keep your child safe online is understanding more about what they are doing when using their devices. With so many games and apps your child will

have some favourites and having regular, informed conversations about what they are doing when using them can help to manage risks they may face. The NSPCC have put together a <u>great new activity</u> to help you get to know your child's favourite sites, games and apps, what they like to use them for and key conversation tools.
