Behaviour Attitudes and Personal Development

With this, we have also seen heightened emotions and increased levels of anxiety amongst many. As a result of both a review of provision to support these emotions and a revised therapeutic approach to supporting children across the school, the strides forward we have seen in emotional wellbeing has been truly inspirational.

Exciting developments for 2022 - 2023

Next year we have further changes and adaptations being made to both Foundation subjects (History, Geography etc.) and Core Subject curriculum (English, Maths and Science) as well as pastoral support for personal development for children and families. One of the most significant changes is going to see the introduction of a new Personal, Social and Health Education (PSHE) scheme, through the program of study Jigsaw. Further information on this will be provided in September. However, we are very excited around the positive impact we know that this is going to have on the development of all children from Reception to Year 6.

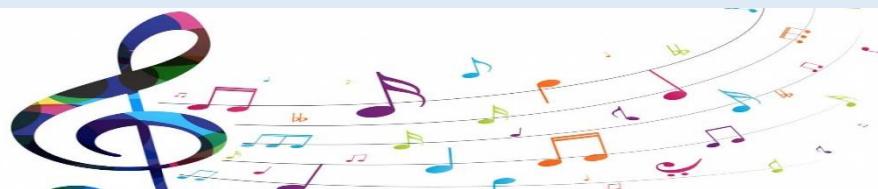
Music Tuition
